We are excited to announce our monthly drop-off and recycle station as part of The Recycle Challenge's Upper 9th Ward Market. Scheduled for September 14, 2024. To ensure the quality and safety of our recycling process, **all items donated must be cleaned.** Here's a list of acceptable items:

1. **Clothing**
 - In good condition only
 - Shoes
 - Accessories (hats, belts, scarves, etc.)
2. **Art Supplies**
 - Cans of paints
 - Brushes
 - Spray paints
 - Crayons
 - Markers
3. **Paper Products**
 - Newspapers
 - Magazines
 - Cardboard
 - Office paper
 - Cereal boxes
4. **Plastic Items**
 - Plastic bottles (rinsed out)
 - Containers (rinsed out)
 - Plastic grocery bags
 - Plastic frozen food bags
5. **Metal**
 - Aluminum cans (rinsed out)
 - Tin cans (rinsed out)
6. **Textiles**
 - Ribbons
 - Fabric scraps
 - Towels
 - Bedding (clean and in good condition)
7. **Furniture (must be in good to fair working order)**
 - Tables
 - Chairs
 - Cabinets
 - Benches
8. **Household Items (must be in good to fair working order)**
 - Books (for resale)
 - Small appliances (toasters, blenders, microwaves etc.)
 - Kitchenware (stainless steel items only - pots, pans, utensils)

Please Note: All items must be clean or cleaned off before drop-off. We cannot accept items that are dirty or heavily soiled.
