The Recycle Challenge Parade and Festival (TRCPF), in its second year "the small festival with a big heart" is scheduled from April 18th to 23rd, 2023, with nightly events and a Saturday day festival. The Earth Day Celebration will be showcasing the best of emerging musicians to seasoned pros playing on April 22, 2023, from 1:00 pm to 10:00 pm. Three areas within the St. Roch Market area: inside the market, the patio features discussions and live performances, and the HEALTHNUTT SYSTEM main stage, set up on the closed street of St. Roch Street at St. Claude Avenue.

Headliner for the main stage is world-renown griot (African storyteller) and kora player, Amadou Fall, better known as Ame Kora from Senegal, West Africa. Ame comes from a family of musicians; his father, Mamadou Fall was a guitarist who played with several well-known Senegalese musicians one being Baba Maal. Ame Kora's magical sounds are best known for the musical soundtrack to the blockbuster movie "Black Panther". For 20 years now, he has performed with various artists such as Baba Maal, Fatou Lowbe, Ibrahim Ba, Djembe Rhythm and Irene Tassambendo, and many more known African and world musicians. His performance with THE RECYCLE CHALLENGE is Saturday, April 22nd, 2023 - Earth Day from 700 pm to 7:45 pm. Since its conception, The Recycle Challenge, for example, has redirected over 20,000 sheets of newspaper from landfills. The repurposed items of unwanted trash are being hand-crafted by volunteers and krewe members who transform them into costumes such as gowns, suits, hats, dresses, and more! As a multinational initiative encouraging folks to participate in community challenges and develop art from recycled materials. The six-nightly events and one-day festival will showcase music, recycling stations & art, local vendors, speakers, and youth activities. TRCPF aims to blend culture, community, and historical connections while addressing key global issues, such as pollution.
